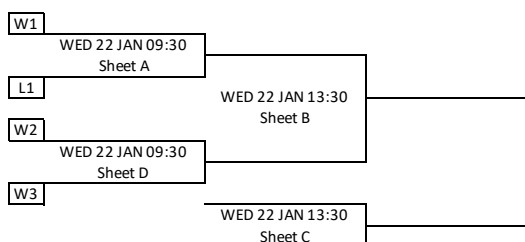

Teams for the Mixed Doubles Competition

At the end of the Mixed Team competition, based on the results, teams will be ranked from 1 to 24.

Since there are two junior women and two junior men on each of those teams, they are coded as player - F1 (playing the first pair of women's stones on the team), M1 (playing the first pair of men's stones on the team), F2 (playing the second pair of women's stones on the team), and M2 (playing the second pair of men's stones on the team).

The Mixed Doubles teams will then be determined using the chart below.

Each Coach will coach 2 teams, both of them with one athlete from his / her NOC.
