We regularly host high-level national and international championships. We have all the equipment required to provide elite playing conditions, and we are committed to continuing to build on this momentum.

The club committee leads the strategy and development of the club. The operational team includes a club manager, a development & sustainability manager, an administrative assistant and an assistant Icemaker. We are a professional, ambitious, and passionate team.

**Your mission**

As Chief Icemaker, you are responsible for preparing and maintaining the ice to ensure top-level playing conditions throughout the season. You apply a modern and rigorous approach, ensuring consistency, quality, and safety.

---

**Key responsibilities**

- Prepare and maintain the ice for all activities: training, leagues, events, and competitions.
- Ensure quality (consistency, safety, “elite” standards) and adapt ice preparation to operational needs.
- Coordinate ice installation at the start of the season (September), including planning and ordering related materials/consumables.
- Coordinate work with a 20% assistant Icemaker (separate position; support/coverage approx. 1 day per week).
- End of season (April): participate in storage, cleaning of the facility, and end-of-season close-down operations.

### **Work organization**

This is a full-time position. Each draw requires an intervention of 1 to 2 hours, depending on needs.

### **Indicative weekly schedule**

- **Monday:** ≈ 2.5 draws
- **Tuesday:** ≈ 2.5 draws
- **Wednesday:** ≈ 2.5 draws
- **Thursday:** ≈ 1.5 draws
- **Friday:** ≈ 1 draw
- **Weekends:** 15 to 17 weekends per season (competitions / training camps)

A complete and detailed ice preparation program will be shared after receipt of applications.

### **Holidays**

Vacations are taken during the summer period (May to August).

During the season (September to March), up to 10 days may be taken to participate in an elite World Curling competition or a similar level event, provided these days do not conflict with major competitions in the club's calendar.

- Proven experience in ice preparation to elite competition standards.
- Proven experience managing end-to-end ice preparation for a curling club over a full season.
- Passion for curling and a constant drive for quality.
- Organized, autonomous, reliable; able to work early/late and on weekends.
- Strong communication skills and team spirit (internal coordination + assistant icemaker).
- Language: fluent English or French required; French is an asset.
